DIRECTED BY ROBERT PRIDHAM. The cult comedy that defined a generation is back! The Graduate, a novel turned quintessential 1960s film, is a newly minted hit Broadway play. Benjamin Braddock has graduated from college, but has no idea what to do next. His future is further complicated by the presence of his parents' friend, Mrs. Robinson, and her daughter, Elaine. Based on the novel by Charles Webb, this play adapted by Terry Johnson is a love story turned bad which will keep everyone on their toes and wanting more. THE PILLOWMAN

DIRECTED BY JONATHAN WIERZBICKI. The Pillowman is a 2003 play by Irish playwright Martin McDonagh. An especially dark black comedy, it tells the tale of Katurian, a fiction writer living in a police state who is interrogated about the gruesome content of his short stories, and their similarities to a number of bizarre child murders occurring in his town. The Pillowman is a challenging fable about the power of words - spoken and written. The play received the 2004 Olivier Award for Best New Play, the 2004-5 New York Drama Critics' Circle Award for Best New Foreign Play, and two Tony Awards. **Warning: a viciously funny, seriously disturbing tale. DIRECTED BY BOB CLINE. This musical by Lionel Bart is based on the book Oliver Twist by Charles Dickens. No one likes a greedy orphan, so Oliver finds himself sold to an undertaker. He runs away, and is taken in by a group of pickpockets who try to teach the innocent boy to be a thief.
