Alex is founder and co-producer of the Curtains on Fire playwrights' workshop and podcast. He's thrilled to be part of this year's Jersey Voices! Bravo to the entire cast and crew!

**SUSAN BROWN-PEITZ** (Playwright, *A Leap of Faith*) is happy to be returning to CCP's *Jersey Voices* on its 30<sup>th</sup> year! Her *Open Doors* was included in *JV 2022*. 
